# L'ORANGERIE

The house stands in its own botanical garden of palms, roses, camelias and citrus trees just steps above the medieval village of Bormes les Mimosas, a "village fleuri" with lush flowers cascading down winding narrow alleys. Walk up the hill behind to the Chapel of Notre Dame de Constance.



## **Accommodation:**

The accommodation is on the upper floor of a beautiful Provencal bastide house with its own separate entrance, newly-modernized and furnished with antiques.

Stunning views from all rooms over the garden and village to the Mediterranean, 4km away. Lovely ambience.

There is a private access road with own parking close to the house. Tranquil setting yet only a few steps through the garden down to the main square of the old village, with its cafes, restaurants, Wednesday market, bookstore (with

international newspapers), and arts and crafts shops and bakers set amidst beautiful, traffic-free streets. Food shops and supermarkets are in the new village further down the hill. Tennis in the courts of the local club. Golf at 10km.

A 22km stretch of preserved coastline contains many sandy, safe beaches within 5-10 minutes drive. Bregancon (with its fort, the summer residence of the French President), Cabaiisson, Estagnol and others are small, beautiful tree-fringed beaches. Behind them lie charming vineyards offering tastings.

A cliff path winds for miles. The beaches of La Faviere run into Le Lavandou, the local resort, with long beaches, harbor, water sports and many shops. Beyond it is another series of charming smaller beaches and two Michelin-starred restaurants.

Take a short boat trip to the four beautiful Iles de Levant. Porquerolles is the most popular, but see the marine nature reserve at Port Cros.

Chic St-Tropez 45 minutes, with its smart people, haute couture and luxury yachts. The old port area is still charming and there is a delightful art gallery.

The naval port of Toulon 45 minutes, Marseille is worth a detour, and the old Provencal cities of Aix, Avignon, Arles and Nimes, with their outstanding monuments, are within easy reach.
